Stan Appleton welcomed everyone at the AGM and presented the CLARO Club League Awards plus a new award for Best CLARO Performance at the 2014 JK – details will be published in the next Clarion.

2. Minutes of the 23rd AGM held on 17th October 2013

Vince Grealy 's surname was amended The minutes were accepted as a true record. Proposed by Phil Headford. Seconded Mike Hind.

3. Chairman's Report

Stan Appleton gave his report covering the year up to 31st August 2014. A copy of the report will be published in the next Clarion. This was Stan's first report as Chairman of CLARO.

4. Treasurer's Report

The Accounts for 2013/2014 prepared by Linda Kelly were circulated. These had been audited and found correct by Richard Kirk. Key issues arising from the report were as follows:

- The accounts are in a good position through careful budgeting for and planning of events with low or zero land charges and where toilet facilities were available thus reducing the need to hire toilets.
- There were no Compass Sport Cup entry fees paid this year as adults paid their own and we did not get through to the final.
- Adult Claro helpers have contributed towards their run at our events by paying £3 for a run.
- We have put on 5 large successful events plus a night event.
- In addition to our main fixtures we have staged many more Wednesday evening events including the Autumn Leaves Street-O, Winter Blues Street-O, Spring Flowers Series and a Primary Schools Series
- This year we made a profit of £3,616.73
- Fees for our events continue to be a standard charge where possible. A budget for each event is prepared as a check.
- The accumulated surplus stood at £9585.93 on 31 August 2013.
- It is our intention to purchase more SI equipment so we can be self sufficient at small events.
- Purchases through the year have included new SI equipment under our agreement with Aire, a new pop up Club tent for use at relay events & funding of coach training courses.

Linda sought views on likely purchase price for members of new club sports jackets on which she is currently obtaining design & supply quotes.

The accounts were proposed by Vince Grealy seconded by Liz Potterton and accepted by all.

5. Membership fees

The membership fees for 2015 as set out below were proposed i.e. no change in fees from 2014. This was approved by a majority vote. Mike Hind drew attention to the fact that $1/3^{rd}$ of Clubs have voted not

to charge any fees but instead require that all their members become members of British Orienteering. The committee were asked to consider this at the next AGM in 2015.
