Eurocity Weekend 15th-16th July: Final Details

Claro are delighted to welcome you all to a great weekend of urban racing in the heart of North Yorkshire. We are especially excited to welcome our visitors from around the world - Norway, Poland, Belgium, Spain, Germany, Ireland and Australia!

Please read these in conjunction with the details for each individual day - the aim is to avoid duplication!

Enquiries

The Enquiries point will be in the Event Centre on both days. This will provide for:

- Race number collection
- Entry on the day for Long, Medium, Short and Accessible courses
- Car key deposit
- SI-card hire
- General enquiries
- First Aid kit
- Space for changing and bags

Race numbers

Numbers will be used for all classes. You must wear your individual number to identify you as an orienteer when in private grounds. You will not be allowed to start without it. Numbers will be allocated in surname order, and published on Racesignup on 13 July after entries close. They can be collected from enquiries where they will be hung on a wire in alphabetical order. It will be a help yourself system, so please check you take the correct number. Safety pins will be provided. Please retain the same number for both days.

Race details common to both days:

Punching: SportIdent punching. SIAC touch free punching will be enabled for controls (make sure you punch the Check box before starting!), but standard punching only for Start and Finish.

Control descriptions: on the map and available loose in start lanes. On Sunday, Short and M/WYJ have both written and pictorial descriptions on their map, with pictorials available loose.

Safety: Both days are being held in busy, popular tourist destinations. Please be extremely courteous when passing members of the public. Great care should be taken and corners should be negotiated wide and slow. A comprehensive risk assessment has been carried out by each organiser, but competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. First aid kit is available at Enquiries. The nearest Accident and Emergency Department is at Harrogate District Hospital, Lancaster Park Road, HG2 7SX.

All competitors must report to download even if they do not complete the course.

Prize-giving for both days will be held as close to 1430 as we can after the Sunday race. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Knaresborough: prizes and certificates for the first three in each junior class, and the winner in each senior class plus Long, Medium and Short.
