**Entries:** Via RaceSignUp until Sun Nov 9th. After this, subject to map availability and

supplement, on RSU until Thu Nov 13th, then at the event on the night only.

**Map:** 1:5000, 5m contours drawn by Quentin Harding, summer-autumn 2025.

**Terrain:** Harlow Hill is a runnable, very gently sloping, mixed plantation woodland with many dogwalker type paths. Birk Crag is a steep valley side, with complex crags (hence the name!), plenty of boulders, very mixed vegetation, and the inevitable path network of a public area. The two areas are linked by a wooded stream valley and a residential road (barely used at night). Very Short does not go into Birk Crag.

**Facilities:** Indoor assembly, toilets. We hope to offer tea/coffee etc.

**Transport:** Nearest railway station is Harrogate. 2.5km - 25-30 mins walk, 10 mins cycle. The frequent 36 bus connects Harrogate station to Ripon and Leeds. There is no service more local to event.

**Parking:** please use public parking along Cornwall Road to the south of the centre, or roadside parking along Duchy Road, respecting local access. You will need to approach the centre along the footpath on the EAST side of Cornwall Road, crossing the road at the signed (unmanned) road crossing to the grass verge on the other side, taped route from there to the driveway. Please take care crossing the road! This route will also be used in reverse by those going to the start.

**Start:** a flattish 600m from Assembly.

**Finish:** All courses except Very Short finish in Birk Crag, close to Assembly. The Very Short finish will be adjacent to the Start.
